

MTCC contracted for construction of Dhoonidhoo harbor and shore protection

The Maldives Transport and Contracting Company Plc (MTCC) has been contracted for construction of Dhoonidhoo harbor and its shore protection, on 04th September 2019. Assistant Commissioner of Police Ahmed Mohamed signed on behalf of the Maldives Police Service and the CEO of MTCC Hassan Shah, signed on behalf of the company.

Under this agreement, the construction of Dhoonidhoo harbor and its shore protection, will consist of 4.61 hectares of dredging and excavation along with 3.75 hectares of reclamation; the construction of a 193 meter long breakwater, a 167 meter long breakwater and a 9.5 meter long breakwater; and a 620 meter long revetment core, and a 250 meter quay wall.

The project is estimated to cost MVR 51,477,222.08
