MTCC awarded Th. Dhiyamigili Coastal Protection Project

MTCC has been contracted towards implementation of Th. Dhiyamigili Coastal Protection Project. The client is the Ministry of National Planning, Housing, and Infrastructure of the Government of Maldives. In a ceremony held today, CEO Adam Azim signed on behalf of MTCC and Ms. Zeeniya Ahmed Hameed, Permanent Secretary signed on behalf of the Ministry.

Scope of works for the project include harbor construction of a 205m breakwater, a 392m revetment. An Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) will be conducted as it is part of the project scope. It is noteworthy that the process of EIA is completed with the involvement of all the stakeholders involved. Therefore, it is essential to conduct the EIA efficiently. With the completion of EIA, all mitigating factors will be taken into consideration and the project will be implemented with the engineering solutions. The value of the project is MVR 23,164,180 million and the project is to be completed within 365 days.

Coastal erosion has been a serious issue at Th. Dhiyamigili for several years and the residents have been facing a lot of difficulties and damages every year during the southwest monsoon. Due to the tidal surge in this monsoon, floods have destroyed crops and residents have had to relocate their homes to other safer areas of the island. With the completion of this project residents of Th. Dhiyamigili will finally get the solution they have been hoping for all these years.

Over the past 41 years, MTCC has delivered various harbor development projects successfully in multiple locations of the Maldives. We have developed our own mobilization techniques and operational procedures to suit the unique environmental and logistical challenges faced in carrying out harbor development projects in the dispersed islands of the Maldives.
