MTCC awarded M. Mulah Coastal Protection Project (Phase 2)

MTCC has been contracted towards implementation of the second phase of the M. Mulah Shore Protection Project. The client is Ministry of National Planning, Housing, and Infrastructure of the Government of Maldives. In a ceremony held today, CEO Adam Azim signed on behalf of MTCC and Ms. Zeeniya Ahmed Hameed, Permanent Secretary signed on behalf of the Ministry.

Scope of works for the project include construction of a 539m breakwater, a 343m revetment, and beach filling of 14.548.25cbm. Additionally, an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) will be conducted as part of the project scope. It is noteworthy that the process of EIA is completed with the involvement of all the stakeholders involved. The value of the project is MVR 38.96 million and the project is to be completed within 440 days.

Over the past 41 years, MTCC has delivered various harbor development projects successfully in multiple locations of the Maldives. We have developed our own mobilization techniques and operational procedures to suit the unique environmental and logistical challenges faced in carrying out harbor development projects in the dispersed islands of the Maldives.
